Born Again

For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him." 3 Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again. Notice how Nicodemus came at night? Why do you think that was?"*

How would you respond to such a statement from Jesus? **John 3: 4** *"How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!" That is how Nicodemus responded. He took it literally and physically. Would you think the same way? Can you imagine how Jesus is going to respond?*

The response from Jesus Christ is so mind blowing. **John 3: 5-8** *Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the*

kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. 6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' 8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."
