this baseball video game. Super Mega Baseball 2 certainly does deserve one. Once I knew how to play I made less errors. I still hit a lot of foul balls. - Paul

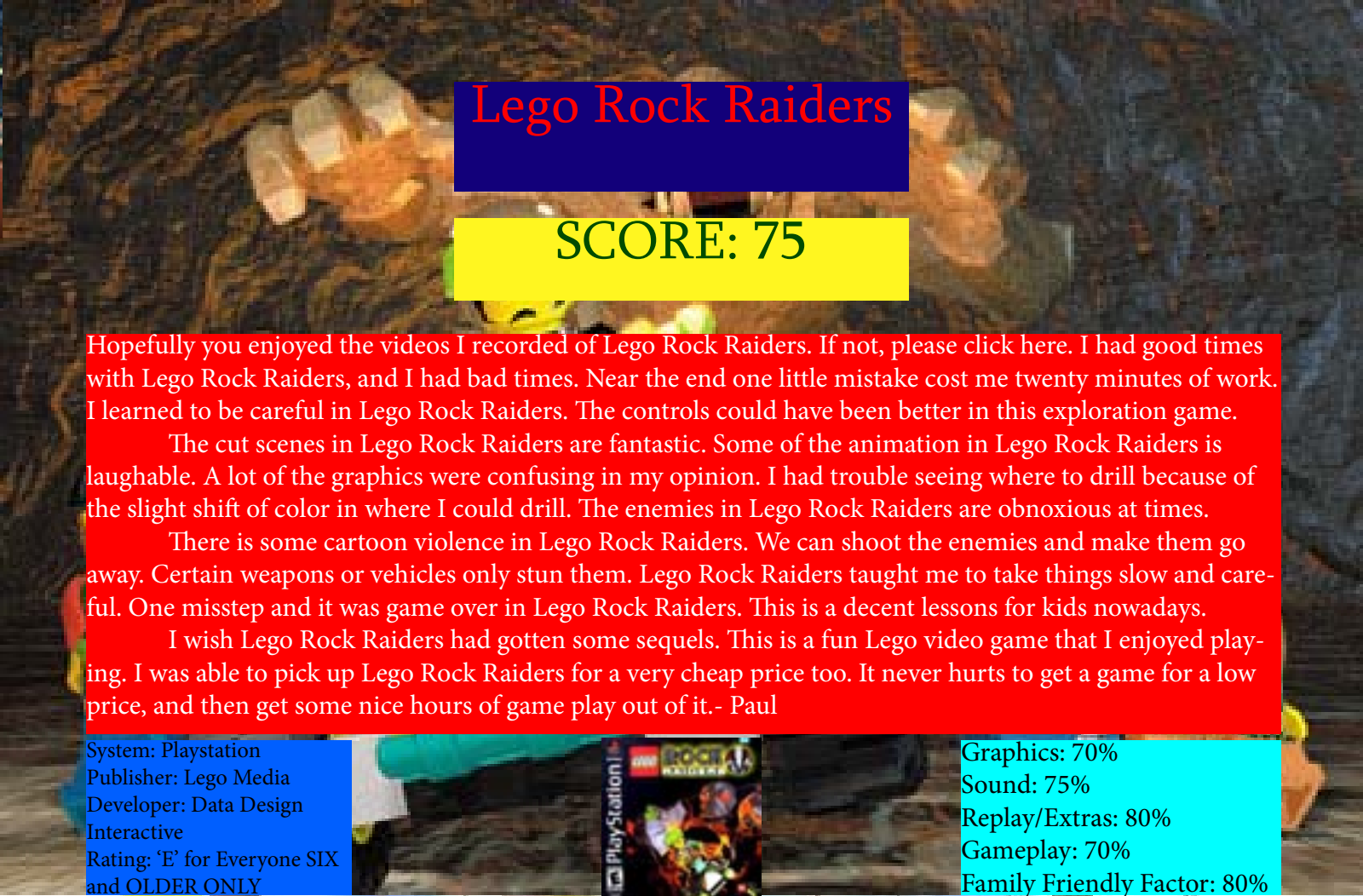
