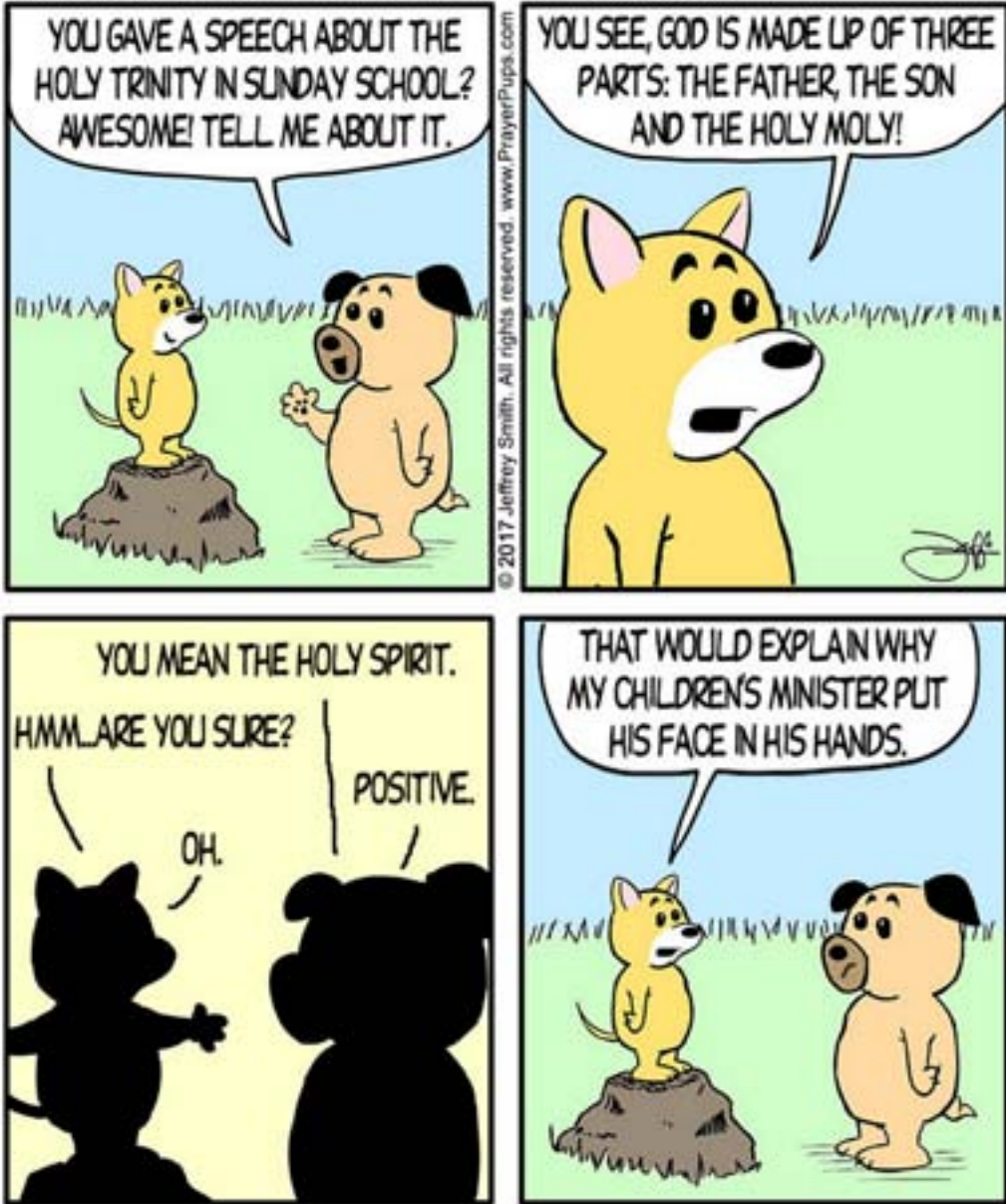

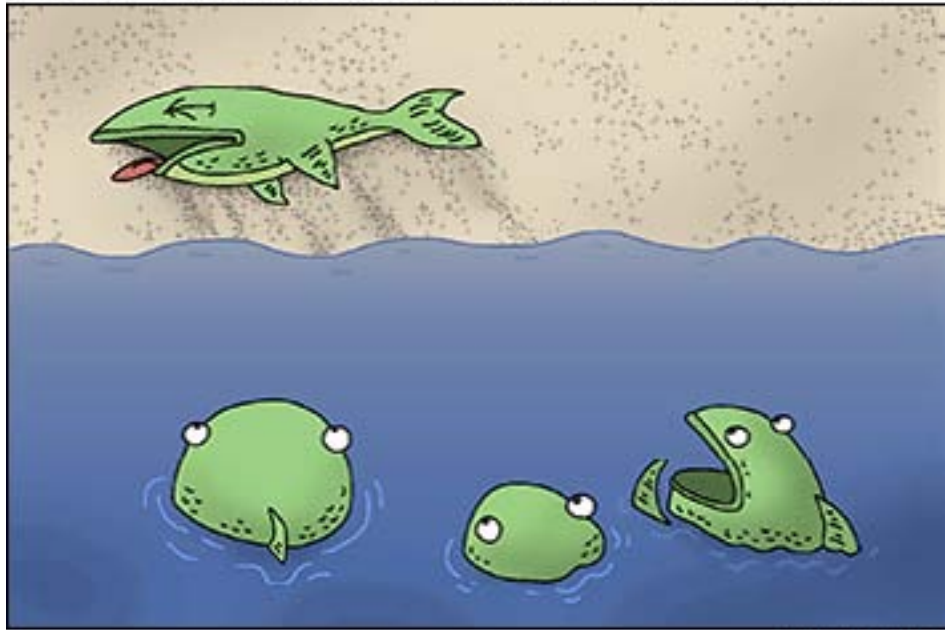
## MISSION STATEMENT

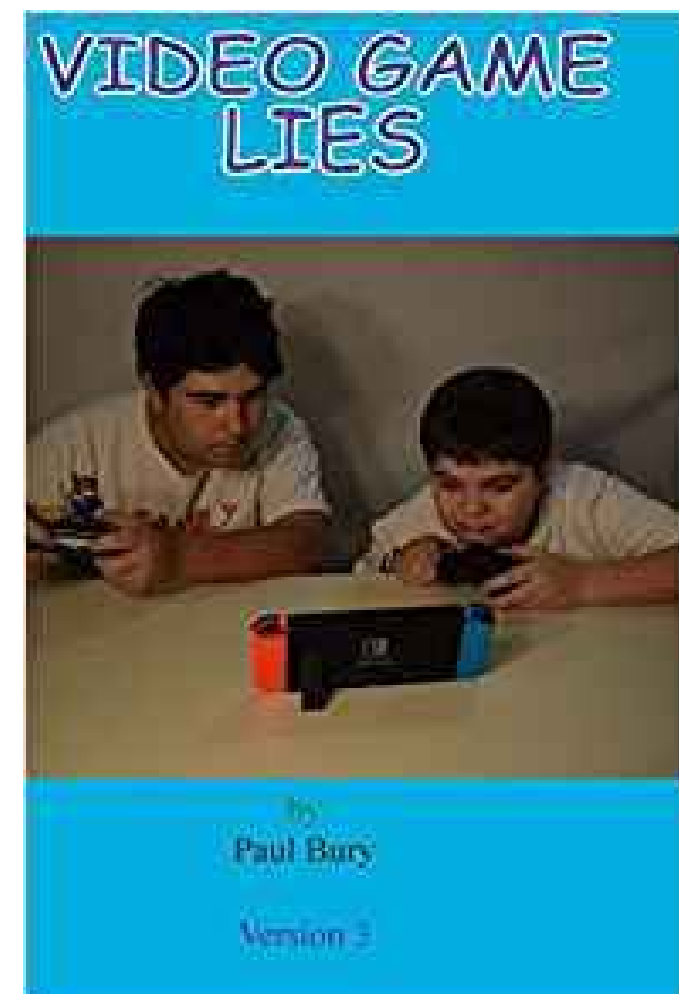

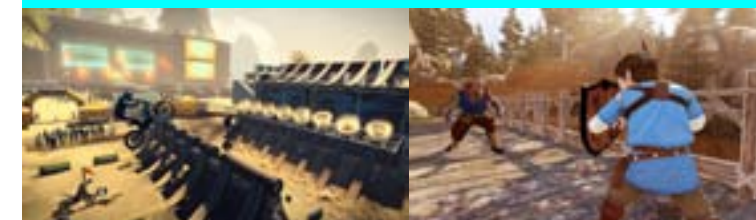

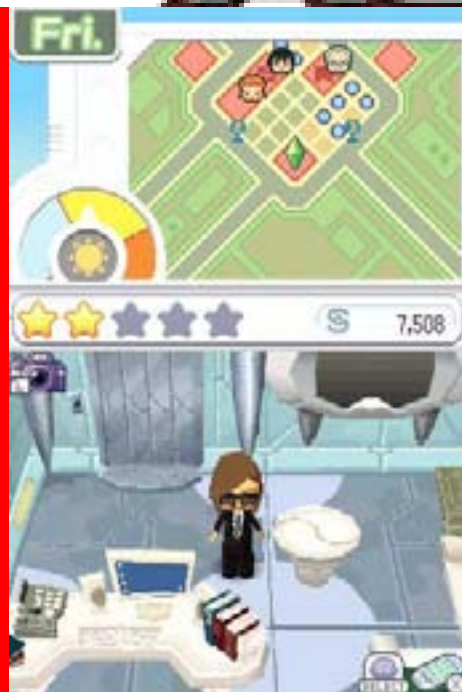
## My Sims Agents

puzzles in My Sims Agents. I also enjoyed helping others in this hand held video game.



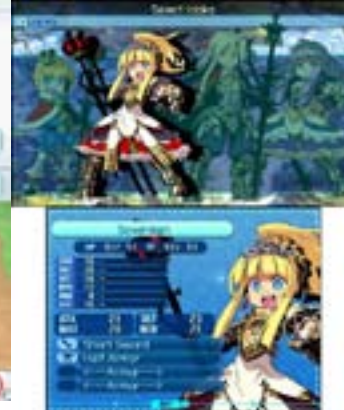

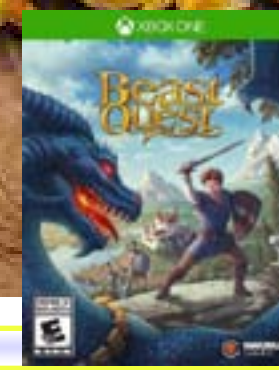
As we battle in Beast Quest we earn skill points. Those can be redeemed for better magical attacks, and improvements on the charac-
