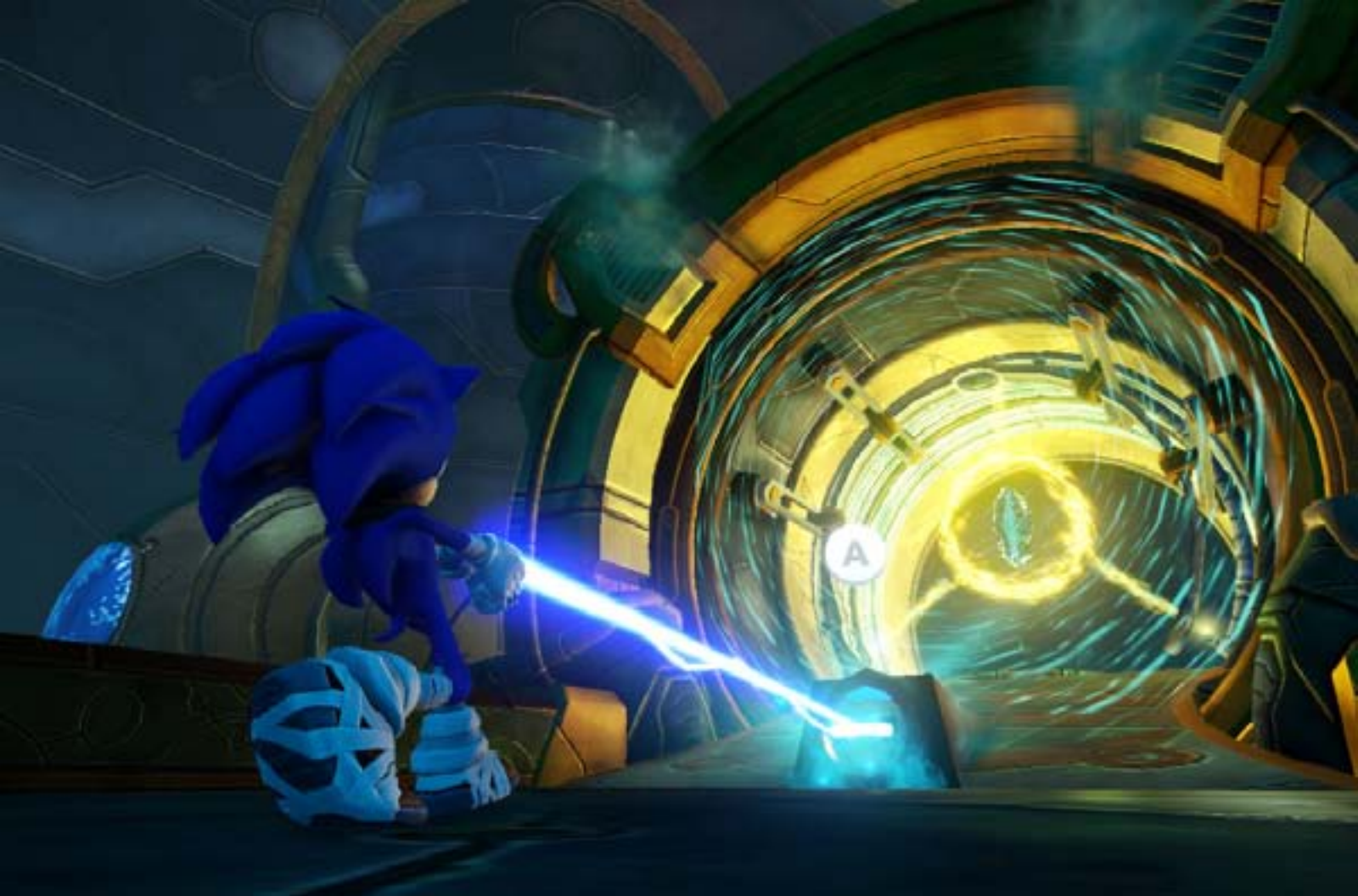
Editor's Desk
