I looked up solar generators and those things are thousands of dollars. It has to be left outside which can be really dangerous here in Memphis since criminals will sneak into people's yards and steal things. That is a major expensive loss if that thing gets stolen. Or even if the solar panels get stolen. So then some security system needs to be implemented in the back yard as well. How much would that cost? Would it even work? All of this for what could amount to a day or two a year of having this problem. Does the cost actually justify the time frame? I just remembered that the solar panels take time to charge the generator. The generator will dissipate the charge if it is not eing used. So you will need to know days ahead of time to charge the unit and be ready with it. That requires time to spend paying attention to the weather all of the time. By the way the weathermen are wrong quite a bit here. Finally the sun needs to be out for the charging to work good. Snow does not really help with the solar panels if you catch my drift.

There are gas generators. I have done some research and they are supposedly not as loud as they used to be. The carbon monoxide is of course still a problem. So they need to stay outside and cords need to be run to them. Great for going camping as long as you have the gasoline to power them. There is still the problem of someone coming and stealing it from outside while you are inside. So we are back to some security system cost on top

of it. Thankfully the gas generators cost less than the solar generators. Why does prepare always seem to mean go out and buy something that you really have no space to house?

All of these issues in Memphis make me want to move. I am getting more interested in living out in the country again. Get some land, chickens and more to live off the land more and better. That feels like better preparing to me. May still need to chain down a solar generator but there should hopefully be less crime out in the country. That is not 100% of course. I will continue to pray about where we should live in the future. I am hoping for somewhere else in a few years.





We do not have this game. It was released on the Nintendo DSi in the online store. Nin-





tendo has since shut down that online store so there is no official way of purchasing it at this time. You could reach out to Ubisoft and request they re-release in some other form or fashion.

Battle of Giants Mutant Insects Revenge is a great example of why we have been such long time supporters of physical copies. When a product is digital only and that store gets shut down there is no way to access it unless the companies involved put it on another platform. Compare that to a physical copy. When there

are physical copies of video games then you can buy, sell, trade, and barter them. A company cannot take it away from you ever. The problems finding a copy of Battle of Giants Mutant Insects Revenge would be less of a problem. If the game did not sell many copies then it might be expensive but it could still be procured.

I also had an errand thought about Battle of Giants Mutant Insects Revenge while typing this response. I decided to check the Nintendo 3DS eShop and actually found this game on that shop. The Nintendo 3DS eShop is shutting down in March of 2023 so you will need to get fast to get it downloaded.

We have a copy of this game on one of our Nintendo 3DS systems. We do not have the ability right now to be able to record this game since the Nintendo 3DS we use for recording has been modified and never updates or connects to the Nintendo 3DS eShop. We are concerned Nintendo would brick that device is we did so. They have bricked other devices on us in the past for using developer made video games.
