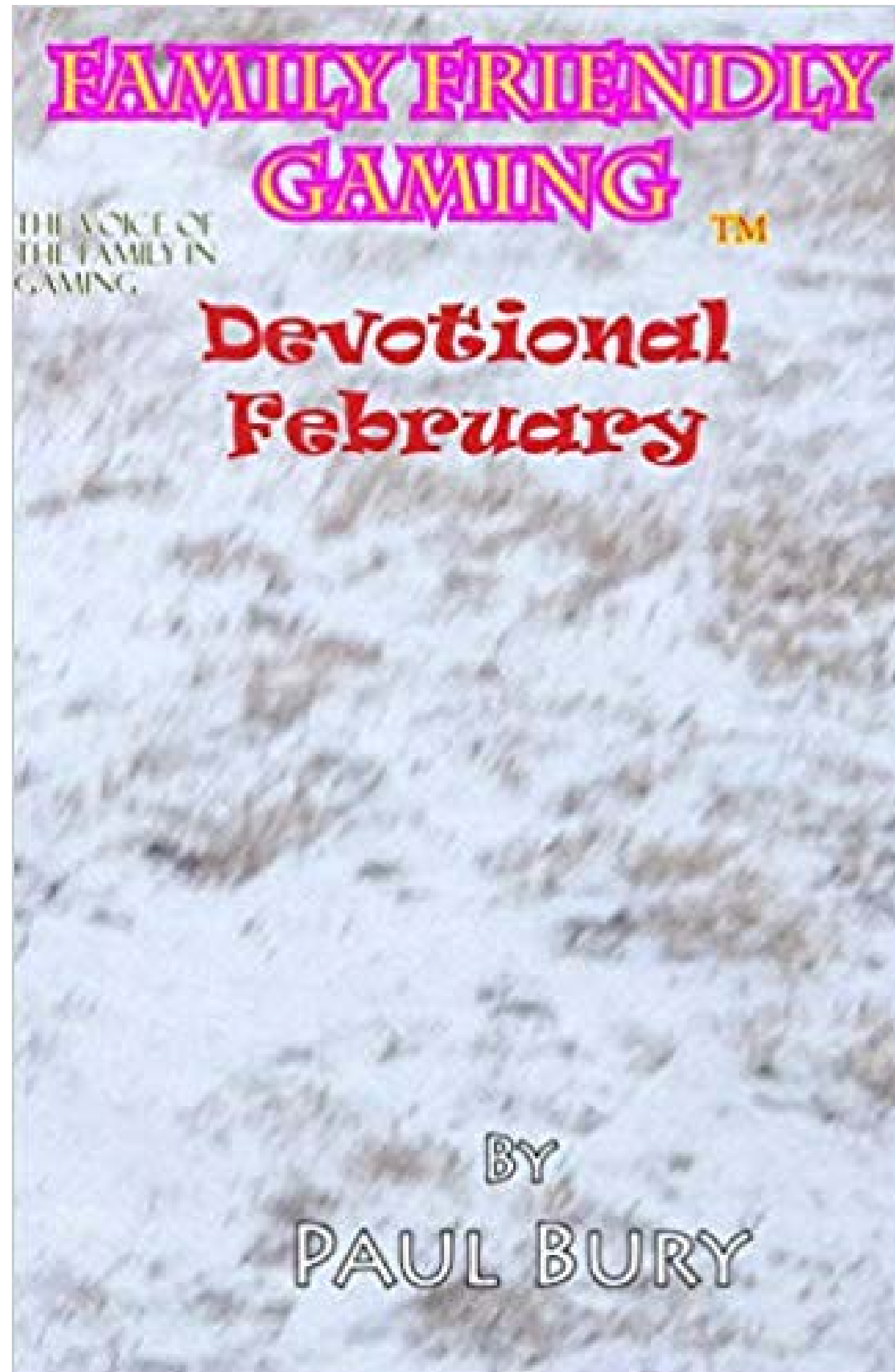
Devotional

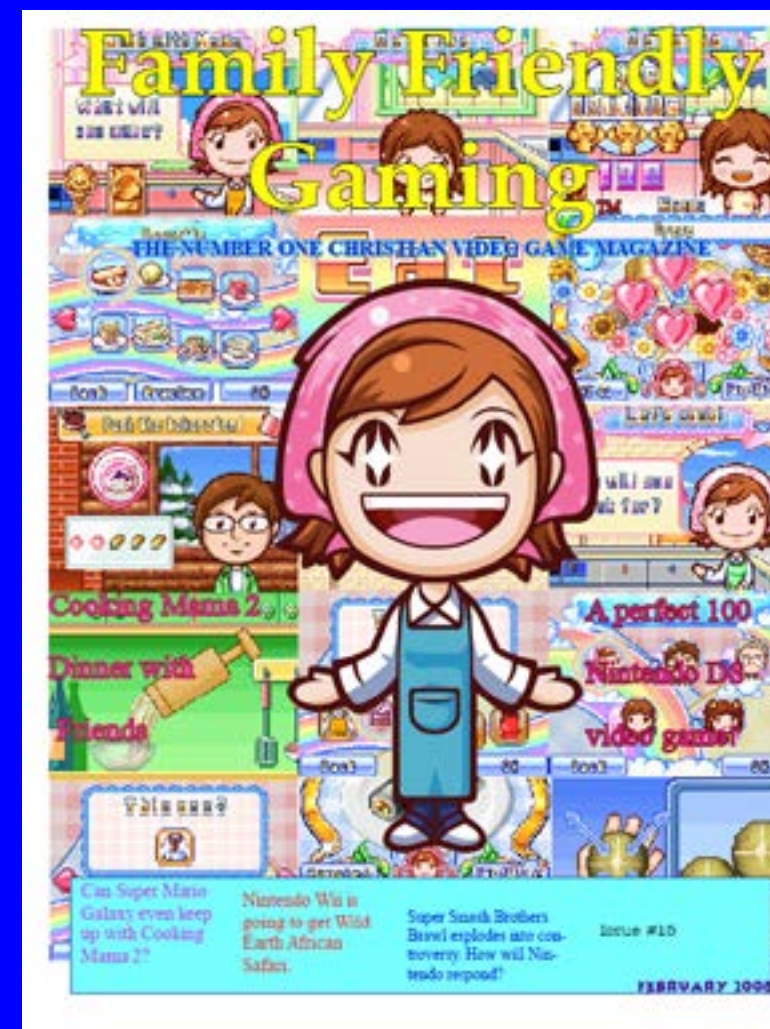

because of the Lord*

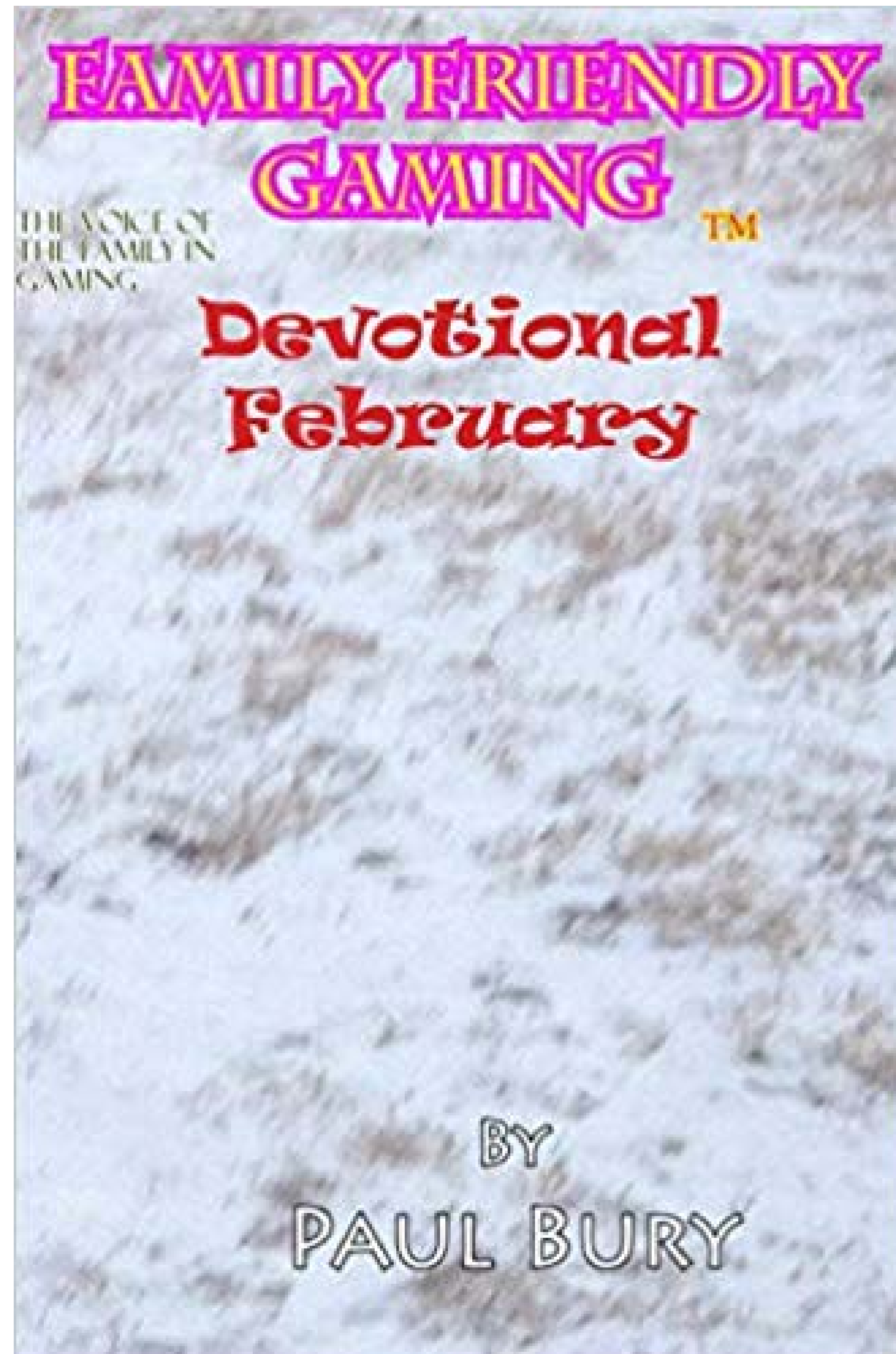
*and his holy words.

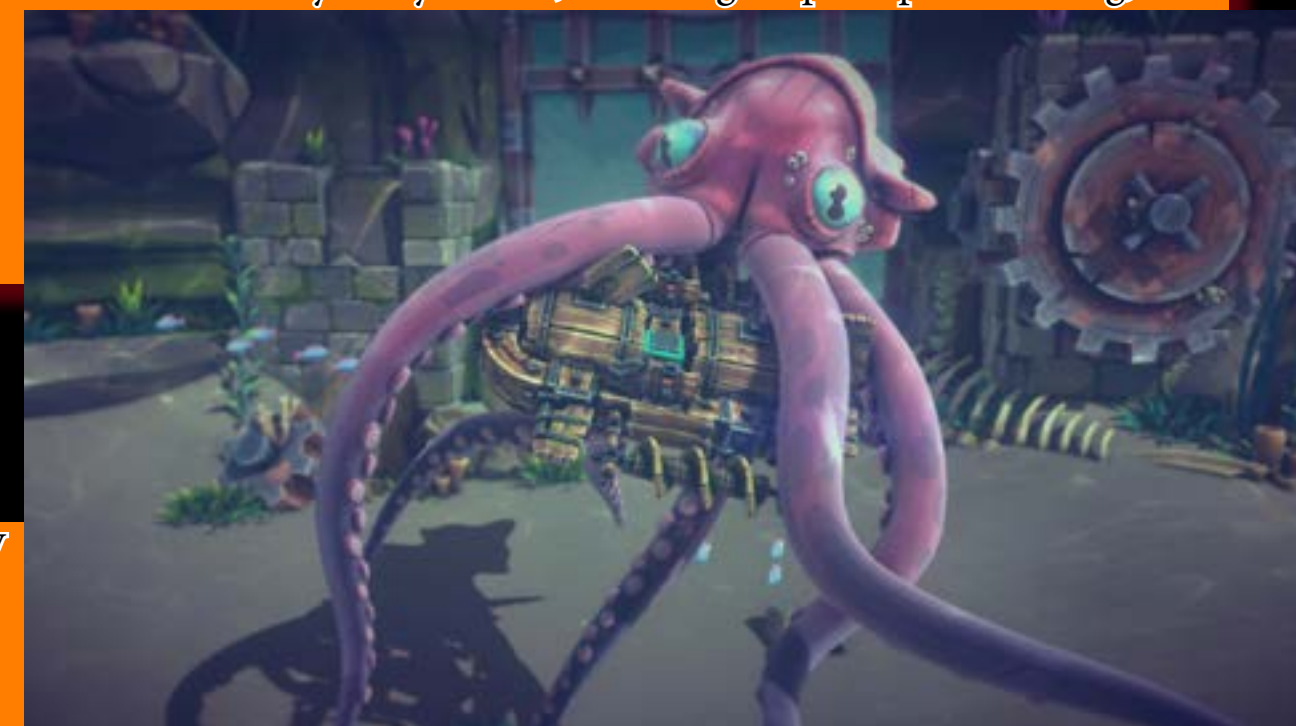

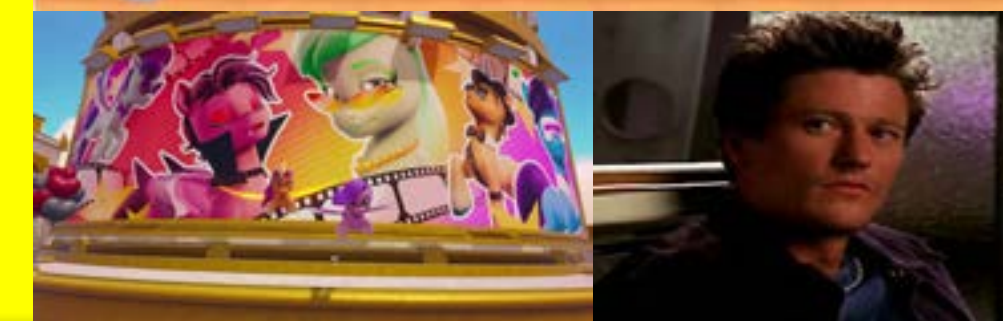

I am very thankful I had the money to purchase a copy of Harvestella on the Nintendo Switch. I live streamed this role playing farming simulating video game for around eight hours on our YouTube channel. A big shout and thank you to all of our viewers, sponsors, donations and supporters. I like some aspects of Harvestella and are annoyed by other ones. There will be spoilers in my review.



The issues families can have with Harvestella are violence, magic, lack of attire, enticement to lust and more. There are very few character choices and the male characters look really feminine. No wonder some younger minds are getting gender dysphoria. Video games like Harvestella are not giving us good and strong male characters. We have fairies and a false goddess belief system in Harvestella. There are seasons and Seaslighs in Harvestella. Between the seasons is a period of death in Harvestella.

Harvestella is an attempt at Rune Factory that falls short

in a great many ways. We can instantly teleport home from these devices once that is unlocked in the game. We can teleport within a specific region to any of the spots we have unlocked. We cannot teleport from one town to another, or from home to a dungeon. We must walk along on the map, or use an animal for a bit faster transportation. We must grind for materials to craft items in the dungeons like repair kits. Time is constantly consumed in Harvestella. It takes an hour to repair a ladder that will give us a



dungeon shortcut. Do not expect to beat a dungeon in a single run. We must go home, sleep, plant, water, and then get back to the dungeon. It takes multiple days per dungeon.

Harvestella looks okay. We can swap different jobs pretty quickly. There is a cool down bar to be able to swap to a different job. There are side quests, and fairies to find. Certain skills take forever to unlock in Harvestella - like being able to break the giant rocks in your garden. There are four giant crystals to explore in Harvestella. The storyline is the only thing that mildly interested me in Harvestella. It was not enough to keep me playing after live streaming this game.

Even the older Rune Factory games are better than Harvestella. Everything that happened with different characters are predictable in Harvestella. We have amnesia, and find a time traveling woman. She comes to live with us. We then explore towns and save the day. - Paul

There are five areas in Moving Out 2 that we drive around. In total there are fifty-seven levels within Moving Out 2. We can complete the primary and optional objectives in each of those levels in Moving Out 2. Some of the levels take practice depending on what obstacles are in your way.



For example we may need to put items on a pulley and then move them across. We can fall and will respawn pretty quickly in Moving Out 2.

The level design in Moving Out 2 gets wild later on. I found odd levels like moving a piece of furniture through an area where balls were trying to squash me and the furniture. 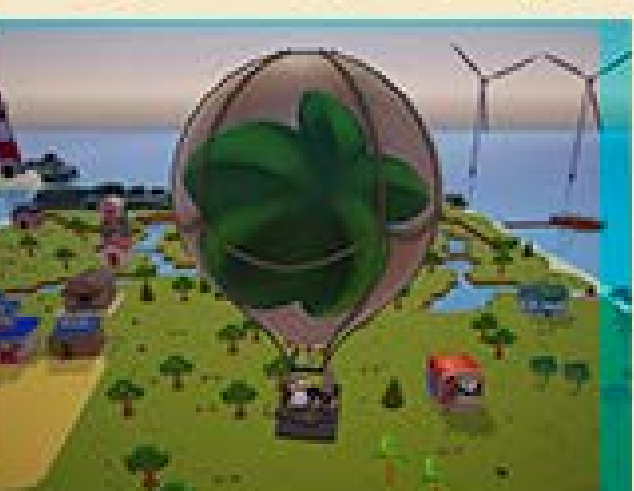

I was actually a bit off after playing Pretty Princess Magical Garden Island. We plant crops, flowers, trees, and more. We collect resources. We then purchase buildings and have the buildings make things. For example we get a Carpentry building and it takes the wood we get from trees and it gives us planks. Planks are then used in making buildings and decor.

Everything in Pretty Princess Magical Garden Island takes a certain amount of time. The crops take five minutes to complete for example. The eggs from the chickens each take five minutes as well. Pretty Princess Magical Garden Island is more of a time management sim that looks like Animal Crossing. We can decorate the town, and resources

take so long to spawn.

Girls that play Pretty Princess Magical Garden Island can take this game at their very own pace. 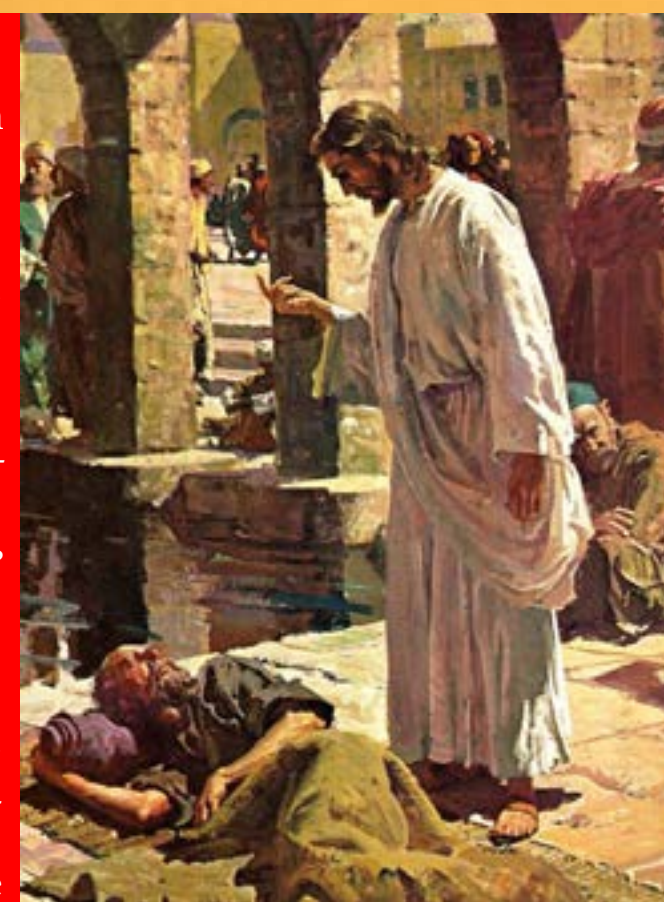

There are three discs in Science of the Bible. It takes five hundred and thirty-three minutes to watch all ten episodes on the DVDs that make up Science of the Bible. I am very thankful I had the money to purchase a copy of the Indie Heroes Collection 3 cartridge on that Evercade family of systems. There are thirteen games on this collection.

The games on Indie Heroes Collection 3 are Donut Dodo, Thunder Paw, Alien Cat 2 Enhanced Edition, Bone Marrow, Big2Small, Magic & Legend Time Knights, Doodle World Redrawn, The Little Tales of Alexandria, Orebody Binders Tale, Bubble Seahorse Adventures, Chew Chew Mimic, Skate Cat, and Chibi Monster Br4wl. There are eight and sixteen bit titles. They are all newly made retro video games from the indie community.

Indie Heroes Collection 3 is the thirty-seventh cartridge title in the main line releases on the Evercade. Some of the titles on the Indie Heroes Collection 3 cartridge are more stand out than others. Bone Marrow and Donut Dodo stick out for me personally. I have played some of these games on other systems in the past like



Thunder Paw, and Alien Cat 2. To be fair Alien Cat 2 is an enhanced edition. The original Alien Cat 2 was released on the first indie heroes collection on the Evercade. I liked it but the Enhanced Edition does not look any better, or sound any better. A lot of rehash to get to any new content in my professional opinion. Donut Dodo feels like an ar-

cade title.

The game that gave me the most difficulty was Pri Pri Primitive Princess. I could not even figure out how to get past the very first level. I tried a plethora of different buttons, and ideas. Nothing worked for me. Sunsoft Collection 2 does not include any hints or explanation about how



to play that game either. Galaxy Fight Universal Warriors is a typical difficult 2D side scrolling fighting game. I did not really enjoy that one.

Sunsoft Collection 2 contains two mascot games in Aero the Acrobat 2, and Zero the Kamikaze Squirrel. The issues families can have with Sunsoft Collection 2 are violence, lack of attire, enticement to lust, magic, and more.
