queens, build their domains, and write their own stories in a lively Roblox world."

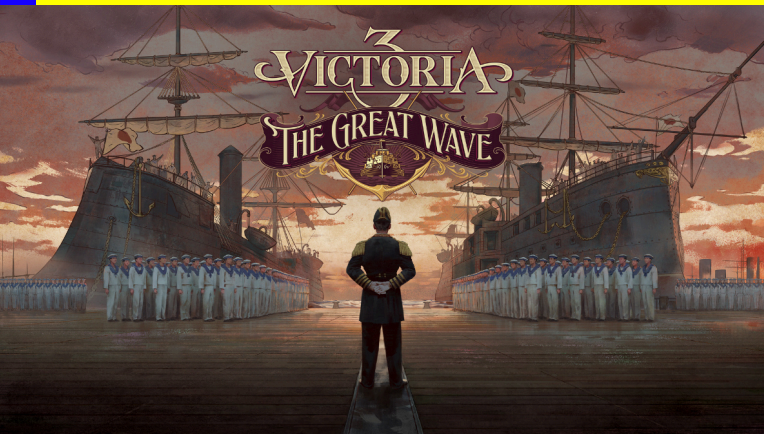

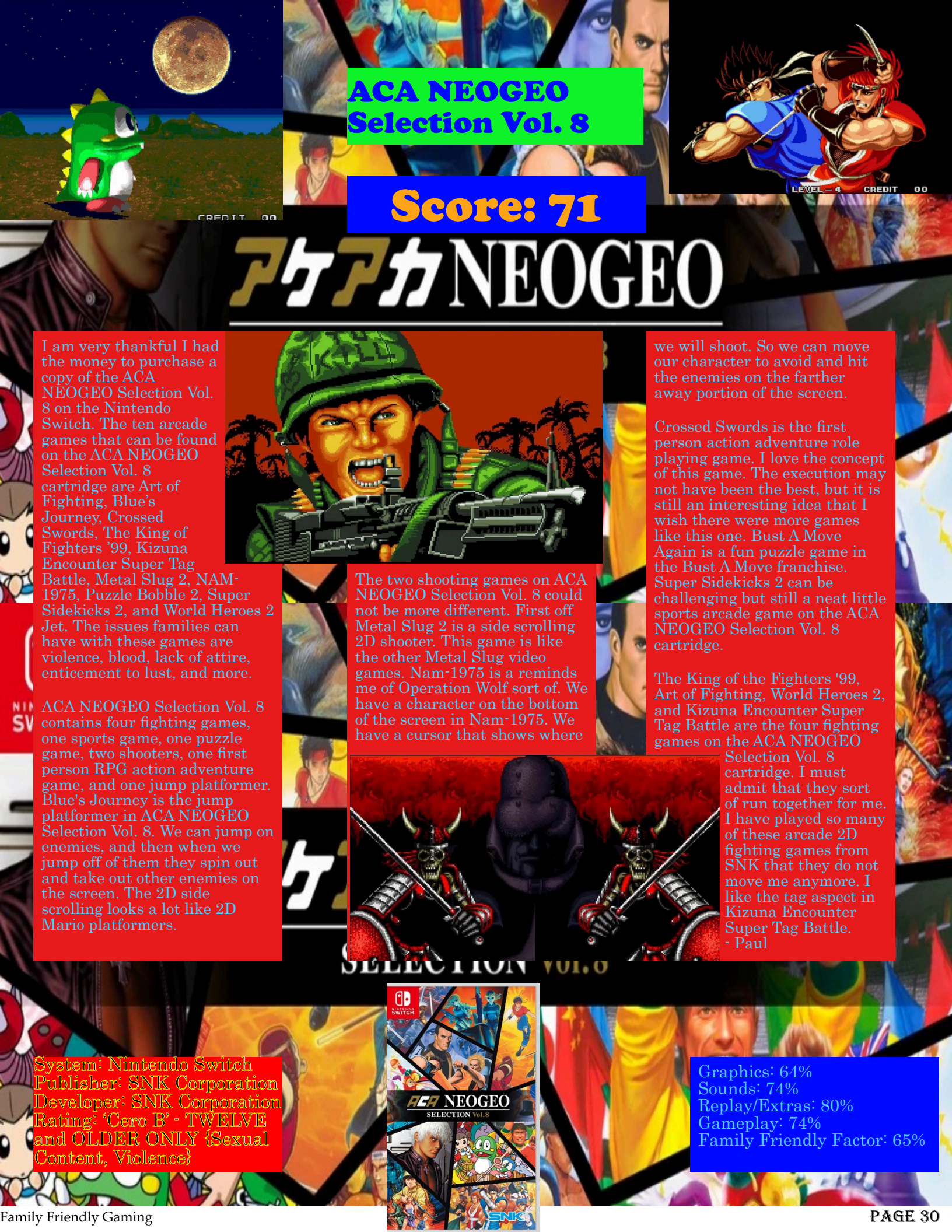

Deku is using multiple different quirks at the same time in the



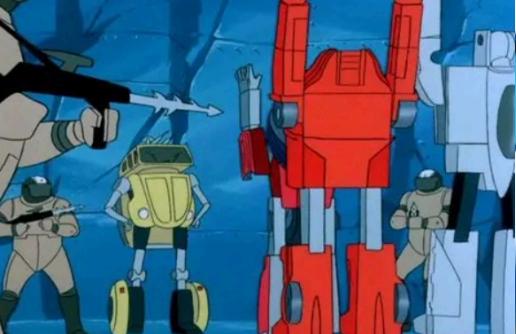
